

Skybus And ERL Will Get You To F1

20 MARCH 2009, BY SEPANG INTERNATIONAL CIRCUIT

To ensure more Malaysians will be able to enjoy the 2009 Petronas Malaysian Grand Prix, transportation service providers SkyBus and Express Rail Link has stepped to assist.

SkyBus, has been named the official bus for the Grand Prix, while ERL will the official rail link.

SkyBus, the famous red bus which issued shuttles to the Low Cost Carrier Terminal, will provide a special direct service to the Sepang International Circuit from various points in the Klang Valley.

The service which will begin from April 3-5 and will start as early as 8am while the return from the track will begin from 4pm except on race day which will start from 6pm.

Fees have been priced between RM4 to RM15 depending on the pickup points.

"We hope that with the special service SkyBus will make it more convenient for fans to attend the race and we also hope it will be able to increase the attendance for the race weekend," SkyBus managing director and CEO Chris S.Thiagarajah after signing with SIC at the circuit today.

Meanwhile for a faster option to the track, ERL, which provides the quickest option to the Kuala Lumpur International Airport, has come up with easy packages for fans.

For the three (3) race days (April 3-5), the public will be able to buy day passes to the track.

For all three (3) days, a pass for one will be priced at RM130, in which applies for a trip to and back from the circuit.

On race day (Sunday, April 5) a day's pass will only RM80 and also applies for one trip in and out.

The passes will include transfer service from KLIA to the circuit and pass buyers will also get one (1) complimentary ticket for the KL Monorail service.
